Meeting Minutes August 7, 2018

Elections proceeded; no changes to board members.

While there was a break-in reported on Amberly, crime is at an all-time low in the community.

The second annual July 4<sup>th</sup> party was a success in Guildford Park. It was more widely-promoted than in the past and was a safe occasion.

The sidewalk has been improved at Saunders Park. Planting has been delayed due to rain, but Evergreen Gene's is on it as soon as weather permits.

Community ride-throughs will continue.

Resident suggested a tracker for Santa.

There is a trend of trash in yards. Debris will also be tagged and residents fined if not disposed of within county policies on trash day.

Resident complained about outdated covenants that are no longer legally enforceable in original Harundale homeowner manuals.

While community ride-throughs are not popular, they will continue. Approximately 1% of the homes in our community are in violation.

Questions raised about the speeding on Amberly. The proximity to the school and double yellow line were mentioned. HOPCA will speak to the police about monitoring that area since it is a cut through before and after work.

Resident who arrived at 6:40 PM asked when we would vote on board members. He was reminded that it was the first order of business and had already occurred.

Don't be afraid to call when you see something small; it's the only way the police or the HOPCA board members learn of issues that could get out of control.

There is no yard sale scheduled yet, possibly in the fall. Perhaps by the former Bateman's location for better exposure.
