Dear Resident:

The Anne Arundel County Department of Public Works is pleased to announce that Thomas Rd has been selected for resurfacing. This project will consist of roadway pavement rehabilitation and upgrades to curb ramps for ADA compliance. The limits of construction on Thomas Rd are Fitzallen Rd to Upton Rd.

We request that you mark out the locations of sprinkler heads or similar fixtures, which have been installed near the work areas. The contractor will make every effort to avoid any private fixtures or systems installed by homeowners within the county right-of-way (ROW), but ultimately these systems are installed at the homeowner's risk. Additionally, we request that you disconnect and reroute any roof drain downspouts and/or sump pump discharges into the county ROW. Discharging these into county ROW is a violation of County Code § 13-2-206 and will have to be redirected by the homeowner prior to construction. Any tree within the county ROW that may be causing damage to county infrastructure will be evaluated for root pruning and/or possible removal if necessary. Any trees removed as part of this project will be replaced with approved street tree specimens following construction during replanting season.

To ensure that this project proceeds in a timely and safe manner, it is important that **all** vehicles be removed from the work areas. The Contractor will post **No Parking** signs along the edge of the road to indicate the work zone. These signs will announce the anticipated dates the contractor plans to work in this area. Vehicles **cannot** be parked in the posted areas during working hours between the posted dates or they **will be towed at the owner's expense**.

Please arrange to have any vehicles that you will need to use removed from your driveway prior to the removal of the existing concrete curb and driveway apron when applicable. When freshly poured concrete has been placed in your driveway area, access to your driveway will remain unavailable for 72 hours while the concrete cures.

Work activities will take place during the day between 7:00am - 5:00pm. During construction, you may encounter a rougher road surface and raised utilities. Please use caution when driving in these areas. To maintain traffic and/or on street parking during construction, work will be performed on one side of the street at a time. Although there may be temporary closures associated with the work, this road will remain open for traffic during construction. Please pay particular attention to equipment, signs, and flag persons when driving through the work zone.
